

## **Middle School and High School Summer Sunday School . . . On-line!**

What you have before you is some simple food for thought to get your teenager and more importantly, family, talking about some real faith issues like- 'Who is Jesus, and what is His message?', 'Why did Jesus die on the cross', and 'Who is God and what is He like?'

Each lesson has the question that is being answered, the big idea that is being hit, and the key Scripture passage. Most lessons also have something to hook the family into the topic. Some of these include YouTube video clips, games, or websites to check out. Following these hook pieces is a simple teaching on the big idea that includes the Scripture passage, followed by some questions to wrestle with that get everyone thinking about the real faith issue presented.

The time will work best if you 'preview' the lesson on your own before bringing it to the rest of the family and feel free to tweak it as you need to! This is meant to be a beginning for conversation in your family about some important Christian themes!

Here's a breakdown of what each lesson covers:

Week 1: Would Jesus play the Beatles: Rock Band?- Who is Jesus and what is His message?

Week 2: The True Avatar- Who is Jesus and what is His message?

Week 3: American Idols- Who is God and what is He like?

Week 4: Is the 'Glee' in you?- Who is Jesus and what is His message?

Week 5: The Father's Song- Will God ever leave or forsake me?

Week 6: What if Jesus had never been born?- Why did Jesus die on the cross?
